RECYCLE

Bins located beside bldg 735

Plastic (#1- 7)

Containers

Aluminum, steel, tin cans
Aluminum foil, trays
Beer, wine, liquor bottles
Food jars, glass jars, pie tins

Paper

Newspapers and inserts
Mail, office & school paper
Magazines, catalogs
Brown grocery bags
Phone books
Shredded paper (in closed paper bags)
Cereal, cracker & pasta boxes
Cardboard, flattened
Shoe boxes, gift boxes
Pizza boxes, milk cartons
Soda and beer boxes
Electronics boxes

Trash ONLY can be placed in the trash dumpster behind bldgs 736-740

Clothing and Household items

Can be placed in the Goodwill Donation Bin next to recycle bins beside Bldg 735

Electronic Equipment

TV, computers, monitors
Computer peripherals, phones

Appliances

Microwaves, dehumidifiers
Air Conditioners

Household, lawn, garden

Mattresses and box springs
Paint, stain, varnish, solvents
Batteries
